It has been really great to see a number of students joining the optional class Zoom meetings. These are a neat way for everyone to catch up with one another, informally. Teachers have been doing some cool activities with students on Zoom and they are all enjoying seeing one another, finding out what everyone has been doing over lockdown. If your child has not managed to make it to a class Zoom yet, then I really encourage you to get them to join them when they are on.

It has been lovely to see the sun a fair bit during lockdown. Unfortunately our school Mini Olympics have been cancelled and we have rescheduled the School Cross Country to the last week of term 3.
