Welcome back to term two! It's wonderful to have everyone back at Pine Hill School after the holidays. Matt and Rama's big sisters completed their primary schooling with us at the end of 2024, Joud has two big sisters at school and CJ has three cousins at our school. Over the next couple of weeks, the Dunedin City Council will be visiting school to do lessons with each class on dog safety and education. Next week classes will begin studying natural weather events and natural disasters and later in the term they are heading to Otago Museum to learn more about this. Following this, we have the much anticipated Senior Learning Team overnight camp at Otago Museum! Staff continue with our structured literacy professional development and implementation of this in our literacy programmes. Later this term, teaching staff will begin professional development on Numicon, the new way we will be teaching maths which will begin in term three. There is a huge undertaking of new information for teaching staff to be learning and implementing this year, including a new maths and literacy curriculum. We are really lucky to have such wonderful and dedicated staff who are working hard to ensure our tamariki are getting the very best education possible.

On Monday I am taking year six tamariki Kahli Little and Nembeka Ganaii to the National Young Leaders Day at the Town Hall. This day aims to develop leadership skills in tamariki through listening to speakers who are leaders in their own fields. Kahli and Nembeka have shown some great leadership skills during their time at Pine Hill School and we are all looking forward to an inspiring day.

This term some of our tamariki have joined up to play mini-ball (basketball) with Scared Heart and St Brigid's School and we have a couple of our older tamariki playing netball for George St School. It is great to be able to join up with other schools so our tamariki have the opportunity to play sports. This year is the first time we have had tamariki play mini-ball which is really exciting. We wish our school sports representatives, and club representatives in rugby and football, all the best for their seasons.

SCHOOL SWIMMING

From **19-30th May** (weeks 4 and 5), all tamariki will be participating in swimming lessons at Dunedin North Intermediate pool in the afternoons. They need to come with their togs, towel and goggles (if they have them) every day during this period. We will be bussing to and from swimming. There is no cost for these lessons as they come under the Government Donation Scheme that we are in.

ATTENDANCE FOCUS

As you are aware, we're placing a strong focus on attendance, aiming for a fantastic 95% attendance rate across the school each and every day. As of today it is **91%**, so we still have some work to do to increase this. To celebrate and encourage consistent attendance, we'll be awarding the Attendance Shield at our Assembly every three weeks to the class that achieves the highest attendance for the three weeks prior to Assembly. Furthermore, at the final Assembly of each term, we'll recognise those tamariki who have demonstrated excellent attendance with special Attendance Awards. We truly believe that being at school, when fit and able, is crucial for our tamariki to achieve to their full potential and learn to the best of their ability. I will be getting in touch with whānau if I am concerned about the attendance rate for their tamariki.
